Madulain find it's self between Zernez and St. Moritz, in the upper Engadine / Graubunden. Our campground is situated right in the village. The easiest way to reach with very large vehicules, is via Zuoz.

- Maloja Pass:** 1815 m. a. s., pass road full of bends, suitable for caravans, max. gradient 9%, class 2, open summer + winter.
- Julier Pass:** 2284 m. a. s., very good pass road, suitable for caravans, max. gradient 13%, class: 1, open summer + winter.
- Bernina Pass:** 2328 m. a. s., very good pass road, suitable for caravans, often difficult to drive in winter! Max. gradient 12%, class: 1, open summer + winter.
- Albula Pass:** 2312 m. a. s., trailers not allowed, suitable only for small campers vans, max. width 2,30 m, max. hight 3,30 m, max. gradient 12%, class: 3, closed in winter (approx. Early december - mid-may).
- Ofen Pass:** 2149 m. a. s., very good pass road, suitable for caravans, max. gradient 10%, class: 2, open summer + winter.
- Flüela Pass:** 2383 m. a. s., very good pass road, suitable for caravans, max. gradient 11%, class: 2, closed in winter (approx. Early january – early may).
- Vereina Car transporter service:** Klosters – Sagliains (Susch), travel time 18 min., departure every 30 min., max. width 2,50 m, vehicules with more than 3,30 m of corner height must be checked-in 15 min. prior to departure, suitable for caravans, open summer + winter.

- Landeck-Scuol-Zernez-Samedan:** No alpine crossing, no motorway charges, suitable for caravans, Landeck - Scuol, class: 1, open summer + winter.  
From Germany access via the Fern Pass (1209 m. a. s., max. gradient 8%).
- Reschen Pass:** 1508 m. a. s., very good pass road, suitable for caravanes, max. gradient 9%, class 1, open summer and winter.

Class 1: easy  
Class 2: medium  
Class 3: narrow
